Item/Activity	Objective	Outcome
For a teacher/ TA to deliver the Wellcomm programme (at least twice a week), following the assessments in Autumn term	To increase children's listening skills and focused attention. To increase the vocabulary that children are able to use to name and describe.	
To use Physical Literacy with small groups/ individuals to build strength and stamina.	To increase core strength and shoulder strength for improved gross motor skills.	
To use dough disco with small groups/ individuals to build strength and stamina.	To increase finger strength and hand dexterity for children's increased fine motor skills to be able to use a variety of tools including writing equipment.	
Provide a school dinner and extend the learning time in nursery. (1 per week).	To learn health and self-care skills (toileting, hand washing, eating) To continue to develop relationships over the lunchtime period.
