

Outcomes for EYPP children 2015-16

6 of the 7 EYPP children in 2015-16 left to start school in July. Three had been in school for five terms, two for four terms and one for three terms. Two were initially poor attenders, which affected their overall progress. All showed increased levels of involvement and well-being over their time in nursery. Three of the children had well-being and involvement levels described as low on entry, three at a medium level. On exit four were judged high and the other two medium.

All of the children arrived at nursery working predominantly in the 22-36mth age band with some areas below this in the 16-26mth level. In most of the 17 areas the EYPP children made at least expected progress and some made better than expected progress, including the boys in the group who both made better than expected progress overall and in the prime areas.
